

FAQs for the East Africa Regional Dialogues

1. What is the East Africa Regional Dialogues? The East Africa Regional Dialogues is a platform centered on driving institutional change to advance gender equality in health leadership. This year's event, themed "Empowered to Lead - Centering Allyship and Gender Equality to Transform Global Health Leadership," aims to deepen understanding of barriers to women's leadership in health, advocate for investment in essential tools for leadership, and explore the role of allyship in advancing gender parity within public and global health institutions.

2. Who should attend the East Africa Regional Dialogues? The East Africa Regional Dialogues is open to all health professionals, researchers, policymakers, civil society members, academics, and development partners who are interested in advancing gender equality in health leadership. The East Africa dialogues is also beneficial to anyone committed to institutional change and enhancing the role of allyship for women in health leadership.

3. Is there a registration fee? No! registration fee is waived for all the delegates

The activities are well curated including an early lunch and networking break, as well as a tea and networking session at the conclusion of the event.
